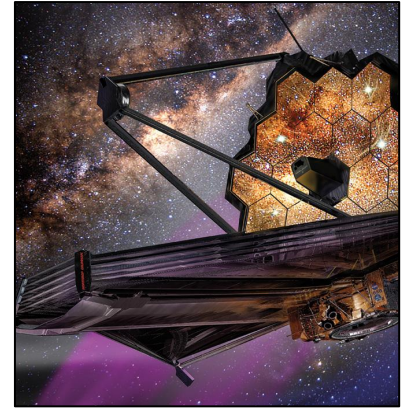


Activity 1 – What’s In Space?

Telescopes are amazing tools which allow humans to observe the faintest objects in the Universe. Telescopes have helped us understand how stars are made, where life might have come from, and how the Universe began. Telescopes often observe things in the Universe we have never seen before, so in this activity, your task is to think about what might be out there and create some space art.
